Q: Where may funeral, memorial, or celebration of life services be held at Camano Chapel?

A: There are four options:

(fixed seating capacity – 50)

East Room

(fixed seating capacity – 100)

Wayland Sanctuary

(fixed seating capacity – 180)

Montgomery Hall

(fixed seating capacity – 699)

Q: Where may receptions or luncheons be held at Camano Chapel?

A: There are four options:

Hearth Room

(table and chair seating capacity – 50,
standing capacity - 75)

East Hall

(table and chair seating capacity – 90,
standing capacity – 252)

Wayland Sanctuary

(table and chair seating capacity – 125,
standing capacity - 250)

Montgomery Hall

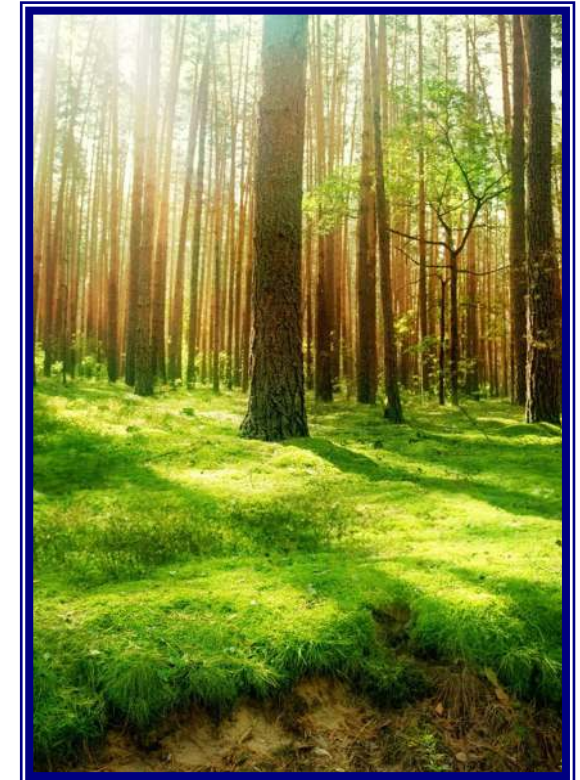
(table and chair seating capacity – 400)

Q: Do we need a funeral director?

A: In cases where burial is scheduled prior to a service, or in cases of cremation, funeral directors are not needed at the service. If a casket is present, funeral directors are also present to handle all arrangements associated with casket placement and movement.

Q: How do I start the process of having a memorial service?

A: Camano Chapel pastors desire to help you plan and lead your loved one's service, whether it's held at Camano Chapel or another location. To begin the process of planning your loved one's service, call (360) 387-7202 x 227 or email info@camanochapel.org, and we will schedule to meet with you as soon as possible. In advance of meeting feel welcome to think about: Preferred service dates and times, anticipated number of guests attending, anticipated family seating needed, special music and scripture requests and preferred memorial recipients. Possible elements of a service can include: Prelude Music, Pastoral Welcome, Faith Story/Obituary, Prayer, Congregational Song(s), Scripture(s), Special or Recorded Music, Sharing (open or predetermined sharing), Message, DVD/Special Presentation (Including: memory videos, Military, Law or Fire memorial or flag tribute), Closing Prayer, Dismissal.

Q: Does Camano Chapel offer grief support as a ministry to families?

A: Yes, you and your family are invited to GriefShare. GriefShare is a special weekly teaching and support time for people grieving the loss of someone close. It's a place where you can be around people who understand the pain of loss. At GriefShare, you'll learn valuable information that will help you through this difficult time in your life. Q: Are there costs to the family associated with funerals, memorials or celebration of life services?

A: At Camano Chapel, there are no costs associated with use of facilities. There are, however, suggested honorariums for some roles associated with these services (see below). Your funeral director will be able to answer facility cost questions associated with other area locations.

Q: Are there costs to the family associated with luncheons following the service?

A: No, the luncheon is a gift to you. Volunteers prepare and serve the meal as a ministry of encouragement to family and friends.

Q: What are suggested honorariums for pastors?

A: There are no honorariums for pastors as our pastors view this as their ministry.

Q: What are suggested honorariums for musicians and technical support?

A: It is appropriate to thank those providing music and audio/video technical support with an honorarium. Feel welcome to ask a pastor or funeral director for suggested amounts.

Q: Can we have a memorial brochure?

A: Yes, at no charge. Be thinking about a special photo you may wish to include on the cover.
