Sermon Series: “*Together Forever*”

Ephesians 4

1. Together forever, **faithful to the truth**. (V. 1a)

Ephesians 4:1 (ESV) — I I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

- Life lesson: Align yourself with Scripture **rather than cultural norms**.

2. Together forever, **living out our calling**. (V. 1b)

Ephesians 4:1 (ESV) — I I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

- Life lesson: Make decisions that **reflect who you are in Christ**.

3. Together forever, **in loyal relationship**. (V. 2b)

Ephesians 4:2 (ESV) — 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,

Life lesson: How to communicate loyalty in God’s family:

1. Find a place **to serve**.
2. Get rid of a **critical spirit**.
3. Protect other’s **reputation**.
4. Rebuke gently and **privately**.
5. Never use **flattery**.

- 1. What are some unbiblical cultural norms?
 - What Scriptures have convinced you that these cultural norms are not of God?

- 2. What are some truths of who we are in Christ?
 - How does our identity in Christ affect our daily lives?
- 3. Do you have a friend who is completely loyal to you?
 - How have they proven their loyalty?
 - What can you do to show your loyalty to other church family members?
