Acts 19:1-20

Three aspects of evangelism—

1. Be intentional with our conversations (Vs. 1-8)

(1 Peter 3:15)

2. Be willing to disciple (Vs. 9-10)

(Matthew 28:19)

3. Be authentic and Christ focused (Vs. 11-20)

(Hebrews 12:2)

S.A.L.T. Group questions

- Have someone read Sunday's passage: Acts 19:1-20
 1. How can we, as followers of Christ, be intentional with our conversations—especially with those who do not believe?
 2. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives?
 3. Why do you think people become "obstinate; they refuse[d] to believe and publicly malign[ed]" Christianity (see v. 9)?
 - **READ 1 Peter 3:15-16**
 - When should we evangelize?
 - How should we approach these conversations?
 4. If you could choose one person today to share Christ with who would it be?
 5. What stops you from talking to this person (this question is not meant for judgement, but honest conversation)?
 6. **READ 1 Peter 1:3-7**
 7. According to what we read in Acts 19:1-20 along with 1 Peter 1:3-7, what does it mean to be genuine (or authentic)?
 8. Verse 20 says, "In this way the word of the Lord spread widely and grew in power." What ways can the church in America do a better job of spreading "the word of the Lord"?
 9. If we are to focus on Christ (love Him) and love our neighbor, what does that look like in 2019?
 - What does a "Christ focused" life look like?
