

## STUDY NOTES – AUGUST 4, 2019 Sermon Series: "First Peter: Stand Firm"

Scripture: 1 Peter 1:20-21

1. The timing of God's plan (V. 20a)
1 Peter 1:20 (ESV) — 20 He was foreknown before the foundation of the world
o Life lesson: God knew we'd be a complete failure, but He went ahead with His plan anyway
2. The personal nature of God's plan (V. 20b)
<ul> <li>Life lesson: Never doubt that <u>God is for you!</u></li> </ul>
1 Peter 1:20 (ESV) — 20 but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you
3. The exclusivity of God's plan (V. 21)
1 Peter 1:21 (ESV) — 21 who through him are believers in God, who raised him from the dead and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

o Life lesson: God's plan is **inseparably linked to Jesus**.

  - O What truths stand out to you?
  - 1. How does the truth that Jesus (and His crucifixion) was foreknown before the world's creation affect our attitude?
    - o Why would God create the world knowing that we would fall away from him?
      - What does this tell us about God?
  - 2. Have you ever felt disappointed in God?
    - o What circumstances led to this feeling?
    - o How did you return to the truth that God is for you?
  - 3. Why is secular culture so opposed to Jesus being the only way to God?
    - o How do you see culture's opposition impacting the church in the next 3 to 5 years?
    - o What are some ways that we, as individuals and as a church, can stand firm under such opposition?
