Scripture: 1 Peter 2:9-10

1 Peter 2:9–10 (ESV) — 9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

#### Who are we?

- 1. A chosen race
  - o Life lessons:
    - Rest in the truth that **God wants you**.

### 2. A royal priesthood

- o Life lessons:
  - Never take for granted your **privileged identity in Christ**.
  - Fulfill your <u>calling as a priest</u>.

### How to fulfill your calling as a priest:

- 1. Go directly to God.
- 2. Offer sacrifices. (Romans 12:1-2; Hebrews 13:15)
- 3. Pray for people (anytime, anywhere).
- 4. Serve in the **temple**.
- 5. Represent God to man.
- 6. Spiritually lead your **family**.
