What we do: *Glorify God. Love people. Make disciples*

How we do it: “*In God’s strength we equip believers with biblical teaching to become more like Jesus and reach the lost.*”

Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

2 Timothy 3:14–17 (ESV) — **14** But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it **15** and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. **16** All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, **17** that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

1. The length of biblical teaching (Vs. 14-15)

2 Timothy 3:14–15 (ESV) — **14** But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it **15** and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

Life lesson: We're on mission together to **teach the Bible from cradle to grave.**

2. The depth of biblical teaching (V. 16)

2 Timothy 3:16 (ESV) — 16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

Life lesson: We're on mission together to **teach the Bible with uncompromising conviction.**

3. The breadth of biblical teaching (V. 17)

2 Timothy 3:17 (ESV) — 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Life lesson: We're on mission together to **teach the entire Bible.**

S.A.L.T. Group questions

- Have someone read Sunday's passage: 2 Timothy 3:14-17
 - What truths stand out to you?

- 1. What are the benefits of having a multi-generational church?
 - How can a church encourage multi generations to all worship together?
 - What are some of the sacrifices each generation might have to make in order to have this kind of church?

- 2. What are the results when churches compromise the message?
 - What are some compromising messages that some churches are preaching today?
 - How can we guard against compromising messages at Camano Chapel?

- 3. What is the value of teaching the entire Bible?
 - Today, the Old Testament is often neglected, but what are some great lessons we can learn from it?
 - If you went to church as a child, what were your favorite stories from the Old Testament, and why?
 - Take some time in your group to pray for our church that we would stand firm on the Word of God, now and in future years.
