What we do: Glorify God. Love people. Make disciples How we do it: "In God's strength we equip believers with biblical teaching to become more like Jesus and reach the lost."

Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

2 Timothy 3:14–17 (ESV) — 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it 15 and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. 16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

1. The length of biblical teaching (Vs. 14-15)

2 Timothy 3:14–15 (ESV) — 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it 15 and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

Life lesson: We're on mission together to <u>teach the</u> **Bible from cradle to grave**.

2. The depth of biblical teaching (V. 16)

**2 Timothy 3:16 (ESV)** — **16** All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

Life lesson: We're on mission together to <u>teach the</u> **Bible with uncompromising conviction.** 

3. The breadth of biblical teaching (V. 17)

2 Timothy 3:17 (ESV) — 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Life lesson: We're on mission together to <u>teach the</u> <u>entire Bible</u>.

      - If you went to church as a child, what were your favorite stories from the Old Testament, and why?
