Jesus Rose from the Dead


Matthew 27:65–66; John 20:19

What You Heard In the Word

- 1. What did Jesus do on the third day after he died? *He rose again*.
- 2. What is the word that means "to come back to life"? *Resurrection*.
- 3. Because Jesus has the power to win over death, what promise has he given to us when we die?
