Scripture: ACTS 3

1. Our priorities (Vs. 1-2)

- Life lesson: Put God first, and He will open doors to touch people's lives.

2. Our resources (V. 6a)

- Life lesson: Offer people what God has given you.

3. Our link (V. 6b)

- Life lesson: Link our ministry to the message of Jesus.

S.A.L.T. Group questions

- Have someone read Sunday's passage: Acts 3:1-6
 - What truths stand out to you?
- 1. What are some of God's priorities for our lives?
 - As we put God first, how does He work through us to minister to other people?
 - Give an example of a time your right priorities led to touching someone's life.
- 2. What resources do we have as a church family to touch people's lives?
 - What resources do you personally have?
 - How can you use your resources in this next week in ministry to people?
- 3. What negative things can happen if we do not link our ministry to the gospel of Jesus?
 - What are some creative ways as a church family we can link ministry to the gospel?
 - What are some creative ways you can personally link your ministry to the gospel?

Spend some time in prayer as a group asking God to give opportunities to touch people's lives.
