Scripture: Acts 3

1. Our center (V. 6)

- Core value: Christianity is Christ.

2. Our connection (Vs. 7-8a; 4:14)

- Core value: Christianity is rooted in relationships.

3. Our attitude (V. 8-10)

- Core value: Christianity is expressed through joy.

 - What truths stand out to you?
- 1. What are some incorrect “centers” that people have?
 - What are some ways that believers can stay centered on Christ?
- 2. What do you miss most about not being at church together?

 - What are some suggestions you have for others in being connected in relationships during the stay-at-home time?
- 3. What does joy look like in our daily lives?
 - How would you rate your level of joy right now?
 - What can you do to increase your joy?
- Take some time to pray for each other that you would stay focused on Jesus, relationships and the attitude of joy.
