

Sermon Series: "Afterlife"

Scripture: Luke 16

The four summits of the believer's afterlife:

- 1. The intermediate separation
- 2. The completion of the body
- 3. The intermediate kingdom
- 4. The completion of the kingdom
- 1. The contrast before death (Vs. 19-22)
 - Life lesson: Our life situation is not a gauge for our afterlife situation.
- 2. The contrast at death (V. 22)
 - Life lesson: What matters most at death is not what is behind us but what is ahead of us.
- 3. The contrast after death (V. 22-23a)
 - Life lesson: For the believer, the best is yet to come!

 - What are the differing attitudes and behaviors between and elderly believer and an elderly unbeliever?
 - 3. How should we live today since the best is yet to come (in our afterlife)?
