



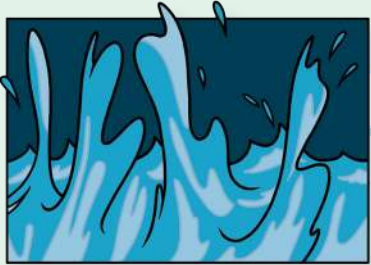

What You Heard *In the Word*

There was one Ice Age after the worldwide Flood about 4,000 years ago. Some animals that we don't see today lived during the Ice Age.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. How many Ice Ages were there? *One.*
2. When did the one Ice Age happen? *After the Flood.*
3. Which Ice Age animal is your favorite? *Woolly mammoth, saber-toothed tiger, or Glyptodon.*
