##### ○ Questions:

1. [V. 19] What does it mean that Jesus preached to the spirits in prison?
2. [V. 21] Why does Peter seem to say that baptism saves us?

#### ➤ Life lessons:

OUR EXAMPLES in a hostile culture	OUR ENCOURAGEMENT in a hostile culture
1. Christ	In Christ, we have an undefeated Savior.
2. The Ark	In Christ, we are safe and secure.
3. Baptism	In Christ, we have a new life.

  - 5. How do you find hope that you are safe and secure in Christ?
    - What are some great scriptures that have brought you security?
  - 6. Have you been baptized as a symbol of the Holy Spirit baptism at your salvation?
    - If so, what was the results of your baptism?
    - If not, what is holding you back from being baptized?
