Scripture: Revelation 21

The four summits of the believer's afterlife:

- 1. The intermediate separation
- 2. The completion of the body
- 3. The intermediate kingdom
- 4. The completion of the kingdom
- 1. Change in the environment Vs. 1-2)
 - Life lesson: In the completed kingdom, the universe will be in complete harmony.

2. Change in the human condition (Vs 3-4)

• Life lesson: In the completed kingdom, all relationships will be in complete harmony.

- 1. What environmental catastrophes have you personally witnessed?
 - How can you reconcile environmental catastrophes with the existence of God?

 - What outdoor activities do you hope to have on the new earth?
- 2. What are some of the tragic results of broken relationships in our world today?
 - What are some secular ideas for how to resolve division and broken relationships?
 - To reflect life in the new heaven and earth, how can we resolve broken relationships today?
 - Do you have a broken relationship right now? What steps can you take that will result in healing in this relationship?
 - Spend time in praise to God that he will heal fallen creation and relationships in eternity.
