Scripture: Revelation 20

The four summits of the believer's afterlife:

1. The intermediate separation
2. The completion of the body
3. The intermediate kingdom
4. The completion of the kingdom

1. Rulers (Vs. 4, 6)

- **Life lesson:** Ruling with Christ is so humbling and underserved.

2. Rebels (Vs. 7-10)

- **Life lesson:** Focus on spiritual activism, not social activism.

S.A.L.T. Group questions

- Have someone read Sunday's passage: Revelation 20
 - What truths stand out to you?
- 1. How do you feel about ruling with Christ?
 - What does this opportunity to rule tell us about God's grace?
 - What does it tell us about our identity in Christ?
 - How can our future ruling with Christ affect our lives today?
- 2. What does the final rebellion at the end of the millennial kingdom tell you about God?
 - What does it tell you about humans?
 - What are some secular methods that Christians used to impact our world?

- Are there any secular methods you have adopted that you now see you should stop?
- In light of obedience to God occurring only through the new nature, how should we relate to nonbelievers?
- Share a name of a person you are seeking to witness to and take some time to pray for them as a group.
