The four summits of the believer's afterlife:

- 1. The intermediate separation
- 2. The completion of the body
- 3. The intermediate kingdom
- 4. The completion of the kingdom
- 1. Rulers (Vs. 4, 6)
 - Life lesson: Ruling with Christ is so humbling and underserved.
- 2. Rebels (Vs. 7-10)
 - Life lesson: Focus on spiritual activism, not social activism.
