Scripture: 1 Peter 4:7-11

1. The imminent return of Christ in relationship to myself (V. 7)

- Self-control
- Sober-mindedness

2. The imminent return of Christ in relation to others (Vs. 8-11)

- Sustained love
- Hospitality
- Inspiring hope

How to live in light of Christ's imminent return:

1. Don't get caught up in signs and date setting.
2. Avoid becoming imbalanced on end time prophecy.
3. Concentrate on God's calling on your life today.
4. Align your priorities toward eternal things.
5. Share the Gospel to lost people in your circle of relationships.
