### Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10-11

#### 1. The call to use our gifts (V. 10)

- Life lesson: Enter into church family life with your unique contribution.

#### 2. The way to use our gifts (V. 11)

- Life lesson: Use your gifts with serious intent to put the spotlight on God.

#### HOW TO USE YOUR GIFTS EFFECTIVELY

1. Identify your gifts through your interests and passions.
2. Be content with the gifts God has given you (i.e. don't compare, don't envy others)
3. Don't chase after sensational gifts or feelings.
4. Be faithful with your gift in everyday life.

#### S.A.L.T. Group questions

- Have someone read Sunday's passage: 1 Peter 4:10-11
  - What truths stand out to you?
- 1. What are some positive results of every church family member serving?
- 2. What are some negative results of some church family members not serving?
- 3. What are some of the results of not serving in your area of interest and passion?
- 4. Do you think there are sometimes when we should just serve in the family where needed, regardless of our gifts?
- 5. What are your interests and passions?
  - What are some ways you can use them to serve our church family? (Once you identify your contribution to our church family, call the church office to find a place to serve.)
- 6. Take some time to pray together as a group that each would use their gifts to build up our church family.
