Scripture: 1 Peter 5:1-4

Today's goal: To learn how to lead God's way.

1. The right methods (Vs. 1-3)

1 Peter 5:1–3 (ESV) — **1** So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed: **2** shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; **3** not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock.

WEAK LEADER	STRONG LEADER
Under compulsion	Willing to shepherd
Seeking personal gain	Committed to self-sacrifice
Domineering	Being an example

2. The right motive (V. 4)

1 Peter 5:4 (ESV) — **4** And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.

o Life lesson: Focus on the eternal reward, rather than temporal rewards.

 - o What are some changes you could make to be a stronger leader?
 - 2. What happens when a supervisor at work who is motivated to lead by getting a pay increase or a promotion?
 - o How do the employees in their department feel?
 - o What happens when a parent leads their children in order to get recognition as a good parent?
 - o Take some time as a group to pray for each other to be better leaders.
