1. The opportunity of turmoil (Vs. 1-3)

 Life lesson: Turmoil can lead to a deeper understanding of God.

2. The futility of humanistic theories (Vs. 4-12)

 Life lesson: Humanistic theories must be rejected before truly understanding God.

1.	The good Samaritan god	"God's priority is for me to do good to my fellow man."
2.	The spiritual experience god	"God's priority is for me to have spiritual experiences independent of Bible doctrine."
3.	The "#blessed" god	"God's priority is to meet my desires so I can be happy and fulfilled."
4.	The sexual/hedonistic god	"God's priority is to accept my sexual lifestyle choices."
5.	The political god	"God's priority is to preserve/change society the way I want it to be."

6. The environmental god	"God's priority is to save the environment from human exploitation."
7. The interfaith god	"God's priority is to merge Christianity with all religions."

3. The necessity of God's revelation (Vs. 13-16)

 Life lesson: Only God can give understanding of the spiritual realm.
