OVERVIEW

Camano Chapel is a Christian, non-denominational, community church located on beautiful Camano Island, WA. Sunday attendance is currently about 450 people with an additional 300-400 viewing from home. Our church was founded 70 years ago in 1951 with the dedication service led by the Rev. Billy Graham. Our 20 acre campus and buildings have been completed debt free through God's provision and the faithfulness of the congregation. We are looking to fill our full-time senior pastor position as our previous pastor has retired after 25 years of faithful service.
